

The Fellowship Award

CSE 2010 will award 24 fellowships to undergraduate or graduate students (or recent graduates) from Harvard, Yale, Cambridge and Oxford Universities. The fellowship award consists of the following:

- Reimbursement of round-trip economy airline ticket from home to Hong Kong with a maximum amount of USD1,500
- Transportation (including airline tickets and ground transport) between Hong Kong and Mainland China
- Accommodation at the host university/school (Fellows will be expected to share a double room with a Fellow of the same gender. Internet connections are available.)
- Daily allowance of HKD150/day for meals and other personal expenses

Selection Criteria

Fellow selection is competitive. Eligible applicants will meet the following criteria:

- Currently enrolled students (or recent graduates) in the undergraduate or graduate programs of Harvard, Yale, Cambridge and Oxford Universities. Applicants of other leading institutions will be considered on an individual basis.
- Open-minded and flexible; eager to learn about new cultures and share own experiences
- Have a desire to teach and mentor enthusiastic students
- A native-English speaker
- Of good academic standing and demonstrate a strong extra-curricular history
- Hold a valid passport for the duration of CSE 2010
- Must be available between July 11 - August 20, 2010

Application Procedure

3. Qualified applicants will be contacted for an interview (phone or in person). The interviews are tentatively scheduled for **February 1-15, 2010**.
